2. Take a moment to re-read v.14. What kind of trouble was psalmist in? What kind of vows do you imagine the psalmist made?
3. As you imagine the future, what does "a place of abundance" (v.12) look like?
4. Take a moment to re-read v.16. Why does the psalmist want everyone to "come and hear"?
5. In what ways can you share your own testimony?
6. Take a moment to re-read v.20. What does it suggest about our God? How does it make you feel to realize this is also true of God's attitude and actions toward you?
7. How can remembering the past and imagining the future contribute to our trust of God in our present times?
