Love Your Enemies- Matthew 5:43-48

1. In Matthew 5, as Jesus teaches about the Law and our hearts, he repeatedly says, "You have heard it said, but I tell you . . ." (Matthew 5:22, 28, 32, 34, 39, 44.). How have these words of Jesus impacted your heart and how have you responded?

2. Jesus speaks of the Father's love. What, in your experience, do you find helps you immerse yourself in the Father's love? Can you think of any steps you might want to take, great or small, to more intentionally and regularly immerse yourself in the Father's love for you?

3. Have you ever made a conscious effort to love an enemy? What happened? How did it go?

4. Can you identify anyone - an enemy or enemies - whom Jesus is calling you to love and pray for?
