

Kingdom Living: Worry

As preached on Sunday, November 15th

Read: Matthew 6:25-34

1. If you had to name your greatest source of worry, what would it be? How does this worry impact your day-to-day living?
2. Jesus tells us in v.25 not to worry about what we will eat, drink, or wear. Why does he say this? What is the connection between these verses and vv.19-24?
3. Why does Jesus call attention to “the birds of the air” in v.26? What point is he making? How does it make you feel to know this is true?
4. Take a moment to re-read v.27. What can we learn from the answer to Jesus’ question?
5. Why does Jesus call attention to “the flowers of the field” in vv.28-30? What point is he making? Do you believe what he’s teaching? Why, or why not?
6. One of our struggles when it comes to trusting God with our money is concern over whether we can invest his Kingdom work and still have enough to make ends meet. Do you think God fully understands what our needs are? (even in today’s economy?) What does v.32 tell us about this?
7. How is God challenging you from today’s text regarding your need to trust him as you seek to live for his Kingdom? How will you respond?
