Read: Psalm 139

2. In v.6 we read, “Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.” What knowledge is the Psalmist referring to? In what ways is it wonderful?
3. In vv.7-12 we read that there is no place on earth where we can escape the presence of God. How does this make you feel?
4. In vv.13-18 we are told that it was God who knit us together in our mother’s womb and that God has vast numbers of thoughts about us! How does it make you feel to know this? Does God feel this close to you?
5. What particular relevance do you think this Psalm has in the midst of a pandemic?
