**Read:** Exodus 3:1-10

1. When Moses fled Egypt, the next chapter of his life story was a 40 year stint as a shepherd in the middle of the desert. How do you think he felt during those years? How would you feel?
2. In vv.2-4 it's clear that God only speaks to Moses because Moses both notices the burning bush and turns aside to investigate. Why do you think that was? Why didn't God just call out audibly to begin with?
3. Have you ever witnessed your own "burning bush" sent by God? If so, what was it like?
4. What can you do to ensure that you have open eyes to see the burning bushes God sends in 2021, open ears to hear what he says, and faith to trust and follow where he leads you?
