As preached on Sunday, February 14, 2021

Read: Mark 9:2-10

1. Mark begins this week's passage with "After six days..." What happened six days earlier? Do you think Jesus' disciples have processed that news yet?
2. In Mark 9:1 Jesus said, "Some who are standing here will not taste death before they see that the Kingdom of God has come with power." What does that mean? How does that statement relate to this week's text?
3. The transfiguration of Jesus is described in vv.3-4. How would you describe what happened? How do you think you would feel if you were there? In what way is this an "unveiling"?
4. Why do you think Moses and Elijah are with Jesus? What do you think they were talking about?
5. How does Peter respond? Why does he want to build three shelters?
6. A cloud surrounds them and they hear a voice from the cloud speaking. Whose voice was it? What is significant about what is spoken?
7. How can we be sure we're ready for the unveiling of God during this Lenten season? In what ways can we be sure that we are listening?
