

## **The House of God**

As preached on Sunday, July 18<sup>th</sup>

**Read:** 2 Samuel 7:1-14a

1. The background of this passage is that David just had several great achievements in short succession. What are times in your life where things were going very well for you? Does your perception of God change depending on how things are going in your life?
2. When are times, whether out of obligation or gratitude, you try to achieve things or do things for God?
3. How does it feel to hear that God doesn't need you? Is there any feeling of freedom that comes with it?
4. Do you struggle to receive gifts? Why or why not? What might God be trying to give you in this season of life that you are struggling to receive?
5. Has God ever come through for you in an unexpected way or a way that exceeded what you wanted or needed?
6. What does it mean to you that God wants to build you home that is free from enemies or struggles? How do you picture this home?
