

THE SPIRIT: Forgotten God

As preached on Sunday, February 6th

Read: John 14:15-17

1. Describe your understanding of the Holy Spirit. Have your experiences of the Holy Spirit been positive? Negative? Some of both?
2. What does it mean to say that we worship a Trinitarian God?
3. Who are the persons of our Trinitarian God? Which can you best relate to and why?
4. We spoke on Sunday about how the Holy Spirit has become, for some, “The Forgotten God”. What does this mean? Do you agree?
5. What are the dangers of “forgetting” the Holy Spirit? What does Romans 8:9 have to say about the importance of the Holy Spirit? (See also John 4:24)
6. Isaiah 40:3 asks, “*Who can fathom the Spirit of the Lord?*” Does this mean that we should just give up trying to understand the Spirit? If so, why? If not, why not?
7. On Sunday we walked through a very brief overview of the Spirit’s work through history. Were you surprised by how involved the Spirit has been? Do you agree that the Spirit is still at work in you and in the Church today?
8. What are some questions about the Holy Spirit, and the Spirit’s work in your life, that you hope to find answers for across the next 8 weeks? (share these with your Small Group)
