Read: Luke 24:1-12

1. Have you ever heard news that seemed just too good to be true? What was the news? How did you respond?
2. As the women walked out to the tomb that first Easter morning, how do you think they were feeling after the terror of Good Friday and the emptiness of Holy Saturday?
3. How do the women respond to the empty tomb? To the appearance of the angels?
4. What reminder do the angels provide in v.7? Why is this important?
5. As the women return to the rest of the disciples and share this amazing news, what is the response? Why did they respond in this way? How would you feel if no one believed your sharing of such great news?
6. Take a few minutes to read Luke 24:13-36. Do you think the disciples believed this time?
7. Do you have trouble believing the Easter story and the promises Jesus made? Why, or why not?
8. What steps of faith might you take this Easter to ensure you have “eyes open” for the ways Jesus may be revealing himself to you?
