

## **The Spirit Among Us**

As preached on Sunday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>

**Read: Acts2:42-47**

1. Near the end of chapter 2 of the Book of Acts, Luke provides us with a snapshot of the four devotions which characterized the first church. Take a moment to list those four devotions and offer a brief description of each.
2. Which of the four devotions do you think was the easiest or most natural? Which of the four do you think was most challenging? Is it the same today?
3. In v.46 we are told that believers met together with glad and sincere hearts. How do you think the managed to experience such joy in their fellowship together?
4. In v.47 Luke tells us that these believers enjoyed the favor of all the people. What does this mean? Which people is Luke referring to?
5. Do Christians enjoy that same favor today? Why, or why not?
6. This first group of Christians was growing in number. In v.47 we're told that God added to their number daily. What caused this growth? Was it something special they were doing? What was the role of the Spirit in that growth?
7. As you read of all the Spirit was doing among this first group of believers, what do you think the Spirit might want to do among us today here at Fletcher Hills Presbyterian Church?
8. How can we more actively open ourselves to the Spirit's work among us?
