

Study Questions for “It’s Complicated”

1. Understanding the doctrine of the Trinity is challenging. If you had to describe the Trinity to someone else, how would you describe it?
2. The Apostle Paul says that we have been adopted into God’s family as children, as sons. Why did Paul deliberately choose the word “sons”?
3. As adopted children (Paul uses the word “sons”) of God and part of God’s family, what privileges do we have?
4. As adopted children or sons of God and part of God’s family, what responsibilities do we have?
5. How do the three persons of the Trinity support us in our roles as children or sons of God?
6. Paul uses a lot of prepositions to describe our roles as children or sons of God. Why are prepositions important as we think about our roles as children or sons of God?
7. As you reflect on your own life, what do you believe are the objects of the prepositions that describe your life as God’s child or God’s son?
