5.	What "Renovation Reality" does Bartimaeus help us to learn in Mark 10:46-52?
6.	How did it feel to you to enter the Mark passage and put yourself in Bartimaeus' place? How did you answer Jesus' question: "What do you want me to for you?"
7.
