Read: Psalm 46:1-7

- 1. What do you read for information or entertainment? How would you describe the way you read when information or entertainment is your goal?
- 2. What does Lectio Divina mean? In what ways is it different than other ways we read?
- 3. The first step of Lectio Divina is READ (Lectio). What are you invited to do as you engage this first step?
- 4. The second step is REFLECT (Meditatio). What are you invited to focus upon with this step?
- 5. The third step is RESPOND (Oratio). What are you invited to respond to in this step? What type of prayer might you offer to God?
- 6. REST (Contemplatio) is the final step of Lectio Divina. What are you invited to do as you engage this particular step?
- 7. Will you commit to giving Lectio Divina a try this week? You can choose a different text each time (the Gospels and the Psalms are great places to start). Or, you can choose a single text that you use each time. Give it a try and see if you experience a new level of communion with your God!
