

### Questions for Further Reflection on John 14:1-6:

1. When we are troubled with uncertain futures that create a tension between Christ's promises and our worldly experiences, how can we not be anxious for the future and continue to trust God and Jesus?
2. Jesus promises that he is making a reservation in God's house for us. In fact, he will come back to accompany us there. How does this promise affect your worldview, attitudes and actions in the present?
3. How is Jesus "The Way" through this world and into the next?
4. If Jesus is the "The Truth," how does he help us discern godly truth considering the varieties of voices in our world who claim to speak and act truthfully?
5. There is so much deception in our world that claims to give life. So much of it is temporary and destructive. How does Jesus "The Life" give life to us in this present day that reflects our future eternal life?
6. How does Jesus' statement in verse 6 "*No one comes to the Father except through me,*" motivate us in the present especially when our world wants to believe there are multiple ways to God?
