Read: John 13:31-35

- 2. In v.31 we learn that Judas has just left the gathering. What is the significance of this?
- 3. In v.34 Jesus tells his disciples that he is giving them a new command. Is it really new? Where have we heard this before?
- 4. N.T. Wright has said the command to love one another is "The simplest, clearest, hardest command of all." Do you agree or disagree? Why?
- 5. How do we love others as Jesus has loved us? What does that look like specifically?
- 6. In what ways will the love we have for one another in the church show the world what Jesus is like? What is the significance of this kind of "observable love"?
- 7. How well has the church done historically at loving each other as Jesus loved us?
- 8. How can we more seriously engage this command together at FHPC?
