- 3. How would you describe the process of "askesis"?
- 4. In what way does the belly of the fish serve as "protective custody" for Jonah? Have you ever felt that you were placed in that same situation?
- 5. What is notable about the prayer Jonah offers from the belly of the fish?
- 6. How do we know Jonah was transformed? Is there evidence in the text?
- 7. In what ways might we choose to enter into God's program of askesis? Perhaps this Lenten season is your chance to start!
