Read: John 4:1-26

1. How does Jesus' conversation with the Samaritan woman challenge social and cultural boundaries of that time?
2. What does Jesus mean when speaks of "living water"? How is it different than physical water?
3. In vv.16-18, Jesus reveals personal details about the woman's life. How does his approach reflect both truth and grace?
4. What do vv.23-24 teach us about true worship? How can this influence how we worship today?
5. Why do you think Jesus revealed his identity as the Messiah so directly to the Samaritan woman in v.26?
6. How can this story shape our understanding of who Jesus is and of how we should interact with people who feel marginalized or unworthy?
