Read: John 21:15-25

1. As their breakfast on the beach concludes, Jesus pulls Peter into a conversation. What three questions does Jesus ask? What three answers does Peter provide? What is Jesus' point?
2. In what ways might Jesus be addressing Peter's tendency to feel superior to the others?
3. Jesus indicates to Peter that he will die a martyr's death. Why would he share this hard news with Peter?
4. Peter is curious about what will come of John's life. When he asks, what does Jesus have to say? In what sense are we called to mind our own business when it comes to God's plans for others?
5. What can we learn from John's closing comments in vv.24-25?
6. What were the four instructive principles we discussed at the conclusion of the message on Sunday? Which was the most impactful to you?
7. What will you take away after spending a full year in the gospel of John?
